



Please take note of Mabalingwe's House Rules and Regulations

- Speed Limit on the **Main road** is strictly **40 km/h**.
- Speed Limit on **Game Viewing & Camp roads** is strictly **20 km/h**.
- Our Game viewing area is open from 6am till 6pm.
- Cycling on bicycles strictly within the camp, cycling outside the camp is prohibited.
- Jogging within the camp is at own risk.
- Pedestrians are not allowed outside the camps.
- Guests are not allowed to use any kind of spotlight when in their vehicle in the Game Viewing areas, this is strictly prohibited.
- When viewing game from your own vehicle, you are not allowed to leave the already established roads.
- Please respect the "**NO ENTRY**" signs.
- No day visitors are allowed, unless specific arrangements have been made with management.
- No Off-Road/Road Motorcycles are allowed.
- Guests are not allowed to remove any trees, wood, plants, birds, animals or any other property belonging to Mabalingwe Nature Reserve Share Block (PTY) Ltd and associated companies.
- Guest are not allowed to feed or harass any of the birds or animals.
- The Reserve offers enough natural food for our animals so please do not feed them.
- Please make sure that you close the doors and windows of the chalet/lodge/caravan/tent to prevent animals, especially monkeys, from entering.
- **STRICTLY NO PETS ALLOWED (BIRDS INCLUDED)**
- Swimming is restricted to pools only.
- Please keep our environment clean, use the litter bins that are provided.
- Unit Assignment: The resort has the right to assign a different unit of the same occupancy to the one originally allocated.
- The resort reserves the right to refuse admittance if the confirmation letter is not produced, or if the number of persons exceeds the number of occupancy per unit. This includes children of all ages.
- Failure to abide by Resort Rules may give rise to eviction at the resort manager's sole discretion.
- Mabalingwe does not take any responsibility for any injury or losses.
- Please be aware of possible power cuts that may take place at the resort that are beyond our control. Due to load shedding and power cuts, please be advised that the resort, management and staff cannot be held liable for power cuts at the resort.
- Please respect the tranquillity of Mabalingwe Nature reserve and our Guests. No loud Noises after 22:00.

Should you exceed the speed limit a fine of R 500.00 will be added to your account, which is payable at reception.

Failure to comply with these rules will result in serious steps being taken against the perpetrators and penalties will be applicable.
